<i>Appropriate clothing and appearance</i>	Eg. Clean overalls and boots, long hair tied back in topknot, short unpolished nails, , no visible piercings	S
<i>Safely approach the horse</i>	Ensures stable door is fully shut or under the control of another operator. Approaches animal in a safe and appropriate manner. Does not cause undue alarm to the animal.	S
<i>Apply headcollar</i>	Applies halter without causing harm or distress to the animal. Finishes with it correctly positioned and at an appropriate tension	S
<i>Tie horse up</i>	Ties a quick release knot to string loop, not fixed ring, resulting in the rope being an appropriate length and the knot being an appropriate tension to restrain the animal.	S
<i>Pick up one front foot</i>	Runs hand down leg and successfully lifts foot.	S
<i>Pick out one same front foot</i>	Demonstrates removal of material from heel to toe using a hoof pick. Cleans collateral sulci of frog but avoids frog itself. Places foot back down rather than dropping.	S
<i>Lead horse out of stable</i>	Unties knot. Holds rope at appropriate length. Ensures stable door is fully open (by action or request to another operator). Leads horse out of stable using appropriate body language and position relative to the animal. Induces animal to move in a manner appropriate to its level of compliance without causing it undue alarm. Walks the animal in a straight line for several steps away from the stable.	S
<i>Turn horse and lead back in</i>	Demonstrates control of animal by turning it away from themselves then leading it back through stable door in a controlled manner. Ensures animal has enough space and does not make contact with doorway.	S
<i>Close stable door and remove headcollar</i>	Turn horse around in stable and close stable door (by action or request to another operator). Remove headcollar and leave stable safely ensuring stable door is closed behind them.	S
